### **LEGISLATIVE CALLS TO ACTION**

The leaders of several conservative groups in the county have met twice and agreed to share information on pending SC legislation so that the members of all of our groups could answer “Calls to Action.” The newly-formed York Area Conservative Coalition (“YACC”) is comprised of the following conservative groups: Clover - Lake Wylie Republican Women’s Club; GPS Conservatives for Action PAC; Reaganites of York County; Republican Conservative Women of Fort Mill; Republican Women Rising of Tega Cay & Fort Mill; Republican Women’s Group Orchard Park of Fort Mill; Watchman Group; York County Republican Women and the York County Republican Party. Dennis Getter had an apt metaphor for the coalition. He said, “Individually, the 9 groups are like 9 garden hoses, but acting together they are like a firehose.”

Attached is a list of some of the issues being studied. **Please let me know if you have a specific interest in one of these issues and would be willing to do a bit of research and write up a Call to Action (like the ones attached) to be shared by all of the conservative groups.**

Also attached are a few “Calls to Action” we have received already, along with a list of the contact information for our state delegation to the General Assembly. If you agree with the Call to Action on a specific issue, *please contact these legislators* about that issues.

The results of our Reaganite survey suggest our members do not want to be bombarded with e-mails from us so we won’t be “mass-mailing” all of the Calls for Action. **If you want to continue to receive Calls to Action please “opt-in” to the Legislation e-mail list by replying “Yes Legislation” to this e-mail and you may get two or three e-mails a week only during the Legislative session.** Alternatively, you can see the Calls to Action on [“Action tab”](#) of the York GOP website. Whether or not you opt-in to the Legislative e-mail list, you will still occasionally receive other e-mails from the Reaganites of York County.
