# **NEW OFFICER: Dustin Tant, Director of Communications**

I am also a member of the Sons of the American Revolution as well as the York County Republican Party where I serve as Third Vice Chair and a member of its Bylaws Committee.

Among the numerous vacancies listed on the website are: <u>Accommodations Tax Advisory Committee</u>, <u>Board of Assessment Appeals</u>, <u>Building Board of Appeals</u>, <u>Economic Development Board</u>, <u>Hospitality Tax Advisory Committee</u>, <u>Keep York County Beautiful Board</u>, <u>RH-YC Convention & Visitors Bureau</u>, <u>York County Culture & Heritage Commission</u>, and <u>York County Library Board</u>.

## **OUR COMMITTEES AT WORK**

As we announced early we formed Reaganite committees so our members can get more involved in REAGANITES. I'd like to highlight three committees already at work. Our Secretary Alice Brite, educator Alice Yoder and George Becker are actively researching important issues such as critical race theory and in-person learning for our Education Committee. Amy Magura is working hard for our Event & Speakers Committee to make our next special event as successful as the Stephen Moore event was.

Lindsay Walker and his Special Committee on Zoning & Planning have already reviewed the several hundred pages of the Recode York County, Zoning and Subdivision Codes Rewrite, as well as York Forward Comprehensive Plan. Additionally, Lindsay has reached out to several county officials including Jonathan Buono, York County Planning & Services Director, and Diane Dil, York County Zoning & Standard Administrator and reports that he is "impressed with the professionalism of County Staff and the vision for future York County growth" as well as with the Charleston consulting group the county is using. We are looking forward to hearing more from this committee perhaps at a special meeting this fall.

#### **LEGISLATION**

The York County Republican Party has formed a Legislative Committee which includes several members of the York Area Conservative Coalition (of which the Reaganites organization is a constituent member group). YACC reports that a few of the Pushback Agenda issues that we have been following have passed:

S0001 - Fetal Heartbeat Bill

S0147 - COVID-19 Liability Protection

S0038 - REACH Act Constitutional Education (much more work to be done on education)

H3094 - Open Carry with Training Act

The YGOP Legislative Committee will continue to follow the other Pushback Agenda issues (see attached PDF) as well as a few other important issues.
