### "HAPPY BIRTHDAY" PRESIDENT REAGAN

The namesake of our group, Ronald Reagan, was born on February 6, 1911. So the Reaganites of York County are sending out this "Special Edition" newsletter. *(The regular February Reaganites newsletter will come out later this month.)* 

### **REAGAN ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

Having worked in Washington, DC in the mid-80's with his administration on grass-roots efforts and having met the great man twice, I personally believe he was the greatest president in the 20<sup>th</sup> century. But my personal prejudice aside, many others believe that too. For instance, <u>a Gallup poll</u> once rated President Reagan as the greatest president in United States history.

Here is what <u>one group</u> rated as his top ten accomplishments are follows:

- <u>Tax Cuts:</u> One of the most well-known Ronald Reagan major accomplishments was his tax cuts, which were designed to benefit the middle class.
- <u>Reaganomics</u>: Tax cuts were just one part of Ronald Reagan's overall economic approach known as Reaganomics, which decreased unemployment and inflation and, over time, revolutionized the country's economic structure.
- **Republican Revolution:** Ronald Reagan energized new generations of Republicans, who continued to lead and develop the party in coming decades.
- <u>Communication Style:</u> One of the accomplishments of Ronald Reagan that clearly influenced later leaders was his charismatic, yet casual, speaking style, which ushered in a new era for political communication.
- America First: Ronald Reagan spearheaded a campaign to re-focus the country's attention back on its own people, an idea that has again taken hold in recent years.
- **Military Might:** Funding and development of the armed forces are a cornerstone of the list of Ronald Reagan major accomplishments, specifically the creation of the Strategic Defense Initiative to combat nuclear pressure.
- <u>Cold War:</u> Ronald Reagan took a hard stance against communism and is credited with bringing about major turning points in the Cold War.
- **Technology:** The development of new technology, to be used for everything from the military to education, was a key part of Ronald Reagan's platform.
- <u>Unusual Path:</u> Ronald Reagan's unique journey from Hollywood actor to governor to president set a new precedent that world leaders do not need to come from insider circles in order to be successful.
- Labor Unions: A Ronald Reagan accomplishment that has gone on to shape policy was his approach to labor unions that were operating outside of the law. He took a hardline against air-traffic controllers who were unjustly striking, setting a precedent that has been pointed to for decades.


