**REAGAN TRIVIA ANSWERS** 

- (1) Ronald Reagan didn't like brussels sprout and wasn't a big fan of tomatoes either according to Nancy Reagan. But he enjoyed jelly beans. According to the Ronald Reagan Presidential Library, his favorite flavor was licorice.
- (2) Ronald Reagan did NOT say "Pay your Reaganites dues to vote for new officers." But the "Gipper" certainly would have agreed with that sentiment and may have even laughed at my not-so-subtle reminder.
- (3) The future President <u>lost partial hearing</u> in one ear when he was hurt on a movie set in the late 1930s after a gun was fired next to his ear.
- (4) Yes. Ronald Reagan had married actress Jane Wyman in the 1940s and the couple was divorced in 1948. He married actress Nancy Davis in 1952. Donald Trump is the second President to have had a divorce prior to his election.
- (5) Reagan officially became a <u>Republican in 1962</u>, but he had grown more conservative during the 1950s as he toured as a General Electric spokesman.
